The TRAIL BLAZER is published each year as a record of the Club's activities and a record of members' hiking accomplishments. In 1956 a group of people who had been hiking under the banner of AMERICAN YOUTH HOSTEL were working on a 22-mile trail. On January 23, 1957, several of them had a meeting to discuss the formation of a new hiking club. They decided to name it THE INDIANAPOLIS HIKING CLUB. The constitution they drafted listed the following: "The purpose of the Club shall be the encouragement of the love of nature; the dissemination of knowledge of the attractions of the out-of-doors; the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings; and the sponsoring of other activities incidental to the foregoing."

Following the desires of the founders, the Club has remained faithful to the objectives for which it was founded. However, the Club has changed with the times and the desires of newer members.

Over the years the Club has been most fortunate in having dedicated officers to guide the Club. During 2017 the following people spent much time and effort in guiding the Club:

2017 YEAR IN REVIEW

The Indianapolis Hiking Club wrapped up another eventful year on September 30, 2017. For the 2nd year in a row we finished the year with 571 members, which includes 58 new members who joined during the year. To remain a vibrant club we need to actively recruit new and younger members. This past year we scheduled 2,248 hikes, second only to 2011 when we scheduled 2,262 hikes. This was the eighth year in a row we scheduled more than 2,000 hikes, making us one of the most active hiking clubs in the country. In aggregate 15,254 members hiked a total of 86,019 miles, down about 5% from a year ago when we had a significant surge in attendance because of the Bicentennial State Park hikes.

During 2017 we followed up the very popular Bicentennial Hike series in 2016 with visits to eight Indiana State Recreation Areas (SRA's). We also scheduled numerous morning, afternoon and evening hikes every day of

the year. We visited numerous state parks, state forests, the Hoosier National Forest, nature conservancy's, the Knobstone Trail, wildlife refuges and numerous rural communities in Indiana and nearby states. Many themed hikes were offered, including wildflowers, museums, concerts, pet hikes, book club hikes, restaurants, flower gardens and opportunities to learn more about the history of our great city and state. Six multiple-day trips were scheduled in Indiana and nearby states and in England. Although hiking remained the primary focus, leaders often tacked on pitch-ins and visits to museums, gardens, concerts and restaurants at the conclusion of a hike. Following a number of regularly recurring hikes, it has become a tradition for hikers to meet for coffee, lunch or dinner. Hiking with the Club is as much a social experience as physical exercise.

Following is a brief recap of the major highlights of the past year.

STATE RECREATION AREA (SRA) HIKES As a follow-on to the Bicentennial State Park Series in 2016, during 2017 we hiked at 8 Indiana State Recreation Areas (SRA's) we missed in 2016.

The hikes were all well attended. Here are the scenic locations, leaders and dates of these hikes.

AWARDS BANQUET AND HOLIDAY PARTY Thanks to a generous bequest from the estate of former member Betty Steed, our annual holiday season party on December 4, 2016 was an unprecedented success. Betty's gift underwrote the cost of the party, thus it was free to members and guests and we had a record turnout of 250 people, almost half the entire club. Social Committee chairperson Janet Cohen and her helpers did a wonderful job decorating the hall and tables and providing door prizes. As usual, the food was great and there was lots of it. Attendees brought donations of foodstuffs and toys which were donated to needy families. Following the meal we recognized 36 winners of the 2016 Achievement Awards, with special shirts donated by Bob Kriz. A highlight of the party was the recognition of members who participated on the Bicentennial State Park series throughout 2016. Everyone who attended at least one state park hike received a commemorative lapel pin. We also recognized 35 members who hiked in all 25 state parks and an additional 18 members who hiked in 20 or more parks. For their impressive achievement these people received a photo book of the state park hikes and special tee shirts.

BRADFORD WOODS Once again we hiked the beautiful woods (even in winter) at Bradford Woods each Tuesday in January, something we have been doing for more than 25 years. Hikes were led by Mary Ann Layman and Ed Wright. Except for one Tuesday, the weather cooperated. As much a tradition as the hike, many of the hikers enjoyed lunch after the hike at either Po's or Gray's cafeteria. Unfortunately, Bradford Woods has raised their fees to hike there, and it is unlikely we will be visiting there in the future – at least not in January 2018.

ANNUAL WINTER WEEKEND Always a popular three day weekend during late winter, this year we visited McCormick's Creek State Park on March 17-19. There were two hike leaders for this popular hiking venue. Ed Wright led the faster hikers and Mary Ann Layman led the more moderate pace hikes and Sunday morning's hike. We had 39 hikers for the AM and PM Saturday hikes and 29 hikers for Sunday morning's hike. Many day hikers joined us since this state park is close to Indianapolis. The weather was good and we even found a few early spring wildflowers blooming which is always a treat in the middle of March.

WILDFLOWER HIKES As she does every Tuesday in April, Mary Ann Layman led hikes at Mounds SP, Holliday Park, McCormick's Creek and the west side of Eagle Creek Park to enjoy the progression Indiana's beautiful wildflowers throughout the month. Mary Ann's knowledgeable commentary (if you pay attention) adds

a lot to the enjoyment. Because of warmer than usual conditions the wild flowers were ahead of schedule, but just as spectacular.

C&O CANAL ONE DAY HIKE Once again Rita Bymaster and Theresa Ray completed 62 miles tying the Club's single day distance record. This is the 2nd time Theresa has completed this incredible distance and the 8th time for Rita, an amazing accomplishment. It looks like they will do it again in 2018.

SMOKY MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK For the 20th year in a row about 50 members and guests descended on Gatlinburg, TN in mid-April for three days of mountain hiking and wildflower viewing. The Smoky's are especially beautiful in early spring. Jeff Edmondson led a new route up challenging Mt. LeConte, his favorite trek in the Smokies. Jim Shoufler led morning and afternoon moderate hikes with a major focus on wildflowers. For the 20th time, Jean Ballinger coordinated this fun trip. In 2018, Jean is turning over the reins to Jim Shoufler.

GNAW BONE CAMP 2017 was the first year that Club members and guests did not stay in the cabins overnight at Gnow Bone Camp during Memorial Day weekend. Still we did visit the camp and hike the beautiful trails on day hikes on Memorial Day and in during Octoberfest in mid-October. Thank Mary Ann Layman for leading hikes at this beautiful location and orchestrating a cook out during the fall visit.

RIDGEWAY TRAIL, ENGLAND Mervyn and Janet Cohen planned and led a wonderful week of hiking in late May along the famous Ridgeway Trail in England which is about 60 miles west of London. Since attendance had to be limited to 22 people, this was not an official Club trip although all the participants were Club members. We hiked morning and afternoons for six days with a mid-day pub break for lunch. Along the way we stayed in scenic villages and historical inns. The scenery and historical landmarks during the hikes were breathtaking, although we did hike frequently in the rain which is typical for England this time of year. Mervyn and Janet deserve a lot of credit for orchestrating this unforgettable trip. They plan to lead a similar trip to the Yorkshire Dales in northern England during 2018.

GETTYSBURG, PA For the third time (also in 2005 and 2010) Ed Wright led a two day tour of Gettysburg, America's most famous Civil War battlefield. In mid-June, 25 members and guests attended a two day history lesson and got a lot of exercise in the process. On Friday we walked the 1st day's battlefield and Culp's and Cemetery hills which saw fighting on the battle's 2nd and 3rd day. On Saturday we explored Devils Den, Little Round Top, the Peach Orchard and the Wheatfield. We finished up by recreating Pickett's Charge to Cemetery Ridge. Overall, it was a very enjoyable and informative two days.

MARY GRAY BIRD SANTUARY Mary Ann Layman led hikes at this special place twice during 2017, in June and again in October that also included a hot dog roast on a beautiful fall day.

ANNUAL PICNIC Always a fun time on the last Saturday in July, our annual picnic at Eagle Creek Park drew about 100 members and guests. Around 50 people arrived several hours early and enjoyed a 5 mile hike. The weather was perfect. People brought their favorite food to share and the Club provided fried chicken and drinks. Thanks also for a generous gift of hiking supplies from a friend of the Club which were free to anyone who wanted them. Many members brought school supplies for under privileged IPS students. Thank you to Janet Cohen for coordinating this and other social events throughout the year.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY On September 15th the Club held its annual General Assembly where the current board was elected. Outgoing president, Phil Smith welcomed incoming president Jackie King. After the election, guest speaker Clark Kahlo, presented his passionate talk entitled "Green Perambulations -- Musings about protecting Indianapolis's natural heritage." Clark was instrumental in creating the protests that help save the old growth trees at Crown Hill Cemetery. Thanks to all the board member who brought snacks to the meeting.

STARVED ROCK AND MATTHEISSEN STATE PARKS IN ILLINOIS We had a great crowd of members and guests for a beautiful Labor Day weekend outing (September 2-4) hiking in these unusual Illinois state parks

with most staying at the Starved Rock Lodge. We had 59 hikers on our first hike to the St Louis Canyon on Saturday afternoon. Sunday there were two hikes with Richard and Edeltraud Evans leading a 10 mile hike with 11 hikers and Mary Ann Layman leading a 6 mile hike with 48 hikers. Monday's hike was in the early morning at Mattheissen State Park where we descended into the Upper and Lower Dells with many interesting water crossings. The features of both of these Illinois state parks were created by the glacier melt waters cutting into sandstone on its way to the future Illinois River basin and consist of many interesting canyons and cliff views of the Illinois River.

CORNWALL, ENGLAND In September, Elaine Wright led a group of 20 hiking club members on a weeklong hiking trip to Cornwall in southwest England. Because the attendance had to be limited, this was not an official Club trip, but everyone was a current or former member of the Club. Everyone had a great time.

BOOK CLUB HIKES This tradition started in 2014 is more active than ever. During 2017 we had had a book club hike every month. Hikers read a different book before each hike and there is a book discussion usually after the hike. Many thanks to Kathy Whalen and Katy Smith who continue to orchestrate this popular program. They already have volunteers lined up to lead for quite a few months in 2018.

WEBSITE ENHANCEMENTS After almost a yearlong effort, Bob Hackenberg successfully migrated the mileage database from Mileage Officer Karen Zimmerman's PC to the Club website. Club members may now view their current mileage on the website and, more importantly, hike leaders may now enter mileage for their hikes. About 30 hike leaders are now routinely entering hike sign-up sheets on the website, thereby relieving Karen of countless hours entering the data from over 2,000 hike sheets on her PC.

CONSERVATION

We had a year of several success' and a great disappointment. We maintained the Coffey Dam Trail at Eagle Creek Park and received free use of the shelter for our annual picnic for our efforts. We also maintained a 2 mile section of the Three Lakes Trail in Morgan Monroe State Forest. We also have several members who have been very active in building bridges and other projects in Eagle Creek. Special thanks to the many members who got involved with the outcry to save the north woods at Crown Hill Cemetery and the logging planned for the backcountry area of the Yellowwood State Forest. The Crown Hill woods has at least been saved for the time being as the Veterans Administration agreed to move their Columbarium project to open ground. The great disappointment came as the DNR and the Governor decided to ignore a public outcry and pleas from many scientists and conservation groups to go ahead and log Yellowwood State Forest for a pitiful \$105,000 after being offered \$150,000 to not cut the forest. This is our heritage and a precious irreplaceable place in our state that is being destroyed for the profit of a few.

This coming year we will continue with our maintenance commitments in Morgan Monroe and Eagle Creek and hope to take on the Boy Scout Trail which is in the north end of Eagle Creek Park. We were instrumental in convincing the City of Indianapolis to build a bridge over Little Eagle Creek that will give access to a large area of the park. Chuck Turner, our Director of Conservation, would like to encourage you all to get involved with the efforts to curb the logging in our state forests. We are over 500 strong and can make a difference. The Tecumseh and Knobstone Trails have become a trail of tears if you try to hike in these areas when you see all the damage. The Sierra Club and the Indiana Forest Alliance are great sources for information as to how you can help and would value your membership. Thanks again for all you do and your continued efforts.

LET'S REMEMBER One of the main reasons that our Club continues to be vibrant after 61 years is because of the traditions established by our long time members. Sixty eight of our members have been active for 25 or more years - 19 for over 40 years. They represent the backbone of our club. Nell Larrison is our longest tenured member with 54 years. She is no longer able to hike, but 50 year member Ed Lavagnino still does every Thursday at Eagle Creek Park. See who our 25 year members are on the "About Us" page on our Club website. Take a few moments to remember long-term members who passed away this past year, including John Behrmann, Tom McKeon, Bud Shipman, Karleen Huneck, Libby Moore, Rory Wyss and Beth Holden.

ON TO 2018 Although we have been hammered with extremely cold temperatures in early January that have resulted in many hike cancellations, we still anticipate 2018 will be another busy year for our club. Once again, we expect to schedule more than 2,000 hikes, allowing our hikers to choose from almost 6 hikes a day. Monthly book club hikes and pet hikes will continue. As will April wildflower hikes and return visits to Gnaw Bone Camp and Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary. We will continue to offer many slow and easy options for our elderly members. Multi-day trips are planned for Philadelphia and McCormick's Creek SP in March, Smoky Mountains NP in April, and Yorkshire Dales in northern England in September. Florida hikes are on the schedule for our winter snowbirds. As always, we will also host an annual picnic in July, General Assembly in September, Oktoberfest at Gnaw Bone Camp in October and an Awards Banquet during the holiday season in December.

A number of our members hike mainly for the exercise, and we offer numerous opportunities if this is your primary interest. For most however, hiking with the Club offers an opportunity to interact with old and new friends. Our Club is very much like an extended family. Do your friends and family a favor and invite them to a hike (we are always looking for new members). Do yourself a favor too and plan to hike more often this year. We look forward to seeing you often this year. If you haven't led a hike recently, make it a goal to lead a hike this year. Everyone loves a new hike and leading is a rewarding experience.
