The TRAIL BLAZER is published each year as a record of the Club's activities and a record of members' hiking accomplishments. In 1956 a group of people who had been hiking under the banner of AMERICAN YOUTH HOSTEL were working on a 22-mile trail. On January 23, 1957, several of them had a meeting to discuss the formation of a new hiking club. They decided to name it THE INDIANAPOLIS HIKING CLUB. The constitution they drafted listed the following: "The purpose of the Club shall be the encouragement of the love of nature; the dissemination of knowledge of the attractions of the out-of-doors; the promotion of outdoor recreation in the form of hikes and outings; and the sponsoring of other activities incidental to the foregoing."

Following the desires of the founders, the Club has remained faithful to the objectives for which it was founded. However, the Club has changed with the times and the desires of newer members.

Over the years the Club has been most fortunate in having dedicated officers to guide the Club. During 2018 the following people spent much time and effort in guiding the Club:

2018 YEAR IN REVIEW

The Indianapolis Hiking Club wrapped up another eventful year on September 30, 2018. Our year end membership was 575 members, up slightly from the prior year. To remain a vibrant club we need to actively recruit new and younger members. This past year we scheduled 1,996, only four short of 2,000, but still an average of 5.5 hikes a day. Even with the slight drop in scheduled hikes we are still one of the most active hiking clubs in the country. Collectively 14,275 members hiked 79,530 miles again down slightly from a year ago.

Throughout the year we continued to schedule numerous morning, afternoon and evening hikes essentially every day of the year. We visited numerous state parks, state forests, the Hoosier National Forest, nature

conservancy's, the Knobstone Trail, wildlife refuges and numerous rural communities in Indiana and nearby states. Many themed hikes were offered, including wildflowers, museums, concerts, pet hikes, book club hikes, restaurants, flower gardens and opportunities to learn more about the history of our great city and state. Six multiple-day trips were scheduled in Indiana and nearby states and in England. Although hiking remained the primary focus, leaders often tacked on pitch-ins and visits to museums, gardens, concerts and restaurants at the conclusion of a hike. Following a number of regularly recurring hikes, it has become a tradition for hikers to meet for coffee, lunch or dinner. Hiking with the Club is as much a social experience as physical exercise.

Following is a brief recap of the major highlights of the past year which covers the period of October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018:

GNAW BONE OKTOBERFEST Our annual Oktoberfest at Gnow Bone Camp was enjoyed by 22 hikers. Before the hike, they enjoyed hot coffee, hot chocolate, donuts, and apples and many stayed to enjoy their picnic lunch and socializing after the hikes. It was a beautiful fall day in Brown County for this annual activity.

ANNUAL WINTER BANQUET Our annual holiday season party was another great success, attracting more than 150 members and guests. After a social hour and a great meal provided by Excalibur Catering, we recognized 34 winners of the 2017 Achievement Awards, each of which received a slouch hat sporting the Club name. We also recognized several new 25 year members. Thank you to Social Committee chairperson Pat Lawler and her team of helpers who organized the event. We also appreciate the many guests who donated toys and foodstuffs which were distributed to needy Indianapolis families.

CHRISTMAS LIGHTS AND COOKIES -This hike has become a tradition and 19 hikers met in Franklin, IN for a hike with a stop half way through the hike at the Layman's home to enjoy hot coffee, hot chocolate, and a large variety of cookies. They continued walking through the town of Franklin enjoying all the beautiful Christmas lights and especially the large Christmas display at Compass Park.

ANNUAL WINTER WEEKEND – Always a popular three day weekend during the late winter, this year we visited Spring Mill State park on March 16-18. There were 31 hikers on the Saturday morning hike, 28 hikers on the Saturday afternoon hike and even 24 hikers on the Sunday morning hike. We had very good weather and even found some early spring wildflowers which is always a treat in the middle of March.

WILDFLOWER HIKES After warm weather in March of 2018, we had a cooler than normal April. The weather was often cloudy and cool and those wildflowers were often closed even in the early afternoons. The flowers and the hikers were wanting sunshine. We did see an eagle's nest while at the west side of Eagle Creek and really enjoyed for some time a pair of courting Pilated Woodpeckers as well as a black rat snake that had just had a meal while at Mounds State Park.

SMOKY MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK About 60 members and a few guests joined in for three days of mid-April hiking in one of America's finest National Parks. This was the Club's 21st consecutive year. The Smokies were beautiful and the weather certainly cooperated. We were a week or so ahead of peak wildflower season, but should make-up for this with our later schedule (April 25th - 27th) in 2019. Jeff Edmondson led a challenging 16-mile route up Mt. LeConte, plus two other long hikes. John Schlechte, filling in this year for Jim Shoufler, led a total of five morning and afternoon moderate hikes.

NEW MILEAGE RECORD In May, Glee Crowder broke the Club's mileage record of 42,590 miles set by Tom Patterson back in 2007. Glee is also the only member to walk over 3,000 in a year four times. She was recognized for breaking the mileage record at the Thursday morning Eagle Creek hike attended by almost 50 people. She received a special tee shirt and a new poem written by David Kincaid. You can read David's tribute to Glee on the website Archives page. Glee who continues to rack up miles at an amazing rate, finished the Club year with 43,763 miles. When she finally hangs it up (her shoes that is), who knows how many miles she will have accumulated.

C&O CANAL ONE DAY HIKE Rita Bymaster and Theresa Ray completed 62 miles tying the Club's single day

distance record; Rita for an incredible 9th time and Theresa for the 3rd time. This year they were joined by four new members, Therese Cokain, Missy Wymer, Madeline Zook and Sara Wingate, who Theresa was responsible for bringing into the Club. Rumor has it most of them are going to try it again in 2019.

OLDENBURG FREUDENFEST 10K WANDERUNG has become an annual event which was enjoyed by 20 hikers in mid-July. After the 6 or 12 mile hike through the hills and woods, most hikers ate some good German food, looked at antique tractors & cars, and listened and danced to good German music.

ANNUAL PICNIC Always a fun time on the last Saturday in July, our annual picnic at Eagle Creek Park drew over 100 members and guests. About half the attendees arrived several hours early and enjoyed two hikes led by Harold Crooks and Ed Wright. The weather was perfect. People brought their favorite food to share and the Club provided fried chicken and drinks. Many members brought school supplies for under privileged IPS students. Thank you to our Social Chairperson, Pat Lawler, for coordinating the picnic and other social events throughout the year.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY On September 15th our Club held its' annual General Assembly. Before the meeting, guests enjoyed a social hour with snacks provided by members of the board. The first order of business was to elect the new board of directors to take office on October 1, 2018. Following the election, outgoing president Jackie King welcomed our new president Phil Smith, who will serve for the second time. After the brief business meeting we heard an interesting presentation by several members of the Eagle Creek Foundation regarding ambitious plans to upgrade the west side of Eagle Creek Park, including 7 miles of new trails, several handicap accessible paved trails and new parking areas. The proposals were largely dependent on receiving a sizable donation from the Lilly Foundation. We are happy to report that early in December the Lilly Foundation granted \$2.6 million in funding that the Eagle Creek Foundation was hoping for, so construction will begin in 2019 and hopefully be complete within two years.

YORKSHIRE DALES NATIONAL PARK, ENGLAND Mervyn and Janet Cohen planned and led a wonderful week of hiking in late September. The Park is in the center of England. Since attendance had to be limited to 22 people, this was not an official Club trip although all the participants were Club members. We hiked morning and afternoons for six days with a mid-day pub break for lunch (and beer) on most days. Along the way we stayed in scenic villages and small historical inns. The scenery and historical landmarks during the hikes were breathtaking, although hikes were frequently in strong wind with rain and rainbows. Highlights include Howarth (the home of the Bronte sisters) the Wensleydale cheese factory, a visit to the home of Janet's cousin, endless waterfalls, a full traditional English Tea at the Devonshire Arms hotel, river walks, hundreds of miles of dry stone walls (many of which we had to climb over), kissing gates (which were well used) and the famous Malham cove with its steep limestone trails. One hiker described this hike as "extreme hiking for the over 70's".

WEBSITE ENHANCEMENTS A Data Committee was formed early in the year and met monthly to review Club processes and supporting technology (mainly the website) with the goal streamlining our processes and reducing our dependence on a few key technical resources (people). Thanks mainly to the efforts of Bob Hackenberg and Karen Zimmerman significant enhancements have been made to the internal website databases and streamlining the previously labor intensive process of loading the bimonthly hike schedule. Most of these efforts were behind the scene and not noticed by our membership. Still a number of visible website enhancements were implemented during the past year, most notably to allow hike leaders to enter mileage for their hikes directly into the website, relieving the Mileage Officer from having to do this tedious task. This effort was reported on in the 2017 Trail Blazer, but we are now happy to report that about 95% of our hike leaders are currently entering mileage and feedback has been very positive. We have also given hike leaders the ability to cancel their hikes on the website. Soon the Membership officer and Treasurer will be able to add new member information and make personal related changes to the website database, rather than handing them off to the mileage officer.

LET'S NOT FORGET One of the main reasons that our Club continues to be vibrant after 62 years is because of the traditions established by our long time members. Sixty eight of our members have been active for 25 or more years - 18 for over 40 years. They represent the roots and backbone of our club. Nell Larrison who is

now 103 years old is our longest tenured member with 54 years. She is no longer able to hike, but 50 year member Ed Lavagnino still does every Thursday at Eagle Creek Park. Take a few moments to remember long-term members who passed away this past year, including Desma Way, Gene and Genie Waltz, Dick Underwood, Mickie Williams, Paula Adams, Jon Theobald, Will Harrer, Louise Crandall and Sam Lloyd.

ON TO 2019 Although we have been hammered with extremely cold temperatures in early January that have resulted in many hike cancellations, we still anticipate 2019 will be another busy year for our club. Once again, we expect to schedule about 2,000 hikes, allowing our hikers to choose from almost 6 hikes a day. Monthly book club hikes and pet hikes will continue. As will April wildflower hikes, spring and fall trips to Morgan Monroe State Forest and return visits to Gnaw Bone Camp and Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary. We will continue to offer many slow and easy options for our elderly members. Multi-day trips are planned for to McCormick's Creek SP in March, Smoky Mountains NP in April, Hocking Hills State Park in Ohio in May and Michigan Upper Peninsula in September. Florida hikes are on the schedule for our winter snowbirds. As always, we will also host an annual picnic in July, General Assembly in September, Oktoberfest at Gnaw Bone Camp in October and Winter Banquet in early December.
