

to the Covid-19 pandemic and the fact that most of our target audience has increasingly gravitated to social media for their leisure activities and many, if not most, have never even heard of our club. We are attempting to address this by joining Meetup (see below), a social networking site, and are encouraged by the recent uptick in the number of new members.

Another and perhaps even greater challenge to our future is the lack of qualified volunteers to back up our extremely loyal but aging technical experts who continue to enhance and maintain our world class computer website and supporting databases. And you can be assured that the ongoing responsibility is definitely not a hand-off endeavor. We need to make it a top priority to develop more technical expertise in supporting our infrastructure, or we will have no alternative but to outsource the ongoing support which would be very expensive. We still have time, but not much of it. We encourage anyone interesting in learning valuable technical skills (web programming) to come forward; our experts will teach you how.

In 2021 the Club sponsored 2,047 hikes - 5.6 hikes a day. Collectively 339 members hiked 87,061 miles in 2021, making us one of the most active hiking clubs in the country. Although there are a number of mall hikes on our schedule (although far fewer mall hikes were scheduled in 2021 because of the Covid-19 pandemic), hiking is mainly an outdoor activity which consists of walking in natural environments, often on hiking trails, rural roads and paved sidewalks and walkways. Hikes were scheduled every day of the year and all members are encouraged to lead. In a typical week 40 hikes are offered, including morning, afternoon and evening choices on most weeks. We visited numerous state parks, state forests, the Hoosier National Forest, Nature Conservancy's, the Knobstone Trail, wildlife refuges and numerous rural communities in Indiana and nearby states. Many themed hikes were offered, including wildflowers, museums, concerts, pet hikes, book club hikes, restaurants, and opportunities to learn more about the history of our great city and state. Although two scheduled multiday trips had to be cancelled or postponed because of the pandemic – specifically the annual Winter Weekend and Highlands of Scotland, three extended stay trips were held to Ohio, Tennessee and Kentucky. Although hiking remained the primary focus, leaders often tacked on pitch-ins and visits to museums, gardens, concerts and restaurants at the conclusion of a hike. Following a number of regularly recurring hikes, it has become a tradition for hikers to meet for coffee, lunch or dinner. Hiking with the Club is as much a social experience as physical exercise.

Following is a brief recap of the major highlights of 2021:

PHASING OUT PANDEMIC RESTRICTIONS: For the first 5 months of 2021 all hikes were still subject to Covid-19 guidelines, which included: Hike Leaders signing up all hikers, requiring all hikers to wear masks during the sign up process, reading a Covid-19 policy statement before every hike and strong encouragement to wear masks and social distance during the hike. Effective June 1, these restrictions were lifted in accordance with CDC guidelines and local government policies. Because of Covid-19 two annual 2021 events had to be cancelled, namely the Winter Weekend and Annual General Assembly. Book Club hikes were also suspended until April, when the weather allowed the book discussion to be held outside. Luckily all other traditional Club events, including over 2,000 hikes, continued unabated in spite of the pandemic.

GLEE CROWDER ACHIEVES 50,000 MILES: On March 18, 2021 Glee became the first Club member to reach 50,000 miles, an incredible achievement considering that she did not join the Club until after 2000. On April 8 the Club held a celebration for Glee at Eagle Creek Park. Besides flowers, accolades from club members and a poem written in her honor, Glee also received certificates of achievement from the Governor, Mayor and Congressman. Glee hasn't slowed down a bit since she

broke the record and she finished the Club year (September 30) with 51,572 miles. Who knows where she will eventually wind up?

HOCKING HILLS GETAWAY, OHIO: Over 35 members traveled to southeast Ohio for two days of hiking the third week of April. Weather was fickle as we hiked in a little bit of snow and rain followed by some sunshine. Terry Roesch, trip organizer, was unable to attend due to an unexpected family death. Jill McFall, along with assistance from other gracious volunteer leaders led all six hikes as planned. Hikers were able to choose their pace as both easy and faster hikes were offered each day. All hikes were well attended. Day one, we visited the magnificent inner gorge area Hocking Hills is famous for, Whispering Falls, Cedar Falls, Ash Cave, and Conkles Hollow. Some trails are rugged with rock scrambling, ravines, many sandstone steps that offer gorgeous views at this scenic wonderland. Day two, two hikes were led at Lake Hope State Park around the lake. After, the group enjoyed a wonderful relaxing lunch at Lake Hope Inn. Finally yet importantly, seventeen hikers enjoyed the easy trek to see the Rock House back at Hocking Hills SP. A few hikers took advantage of one of the many tourist activities in the area visiting a hand blown glass studio.

24th ANNUAL SMOKY MOUNTAINS WEEKEND, TENNESSEE: 24 members and guests attended the 2021 Smoky Mountains long weekend, April 15 - 17. We offered 3 challenging full-day hikes and 7 moderate hike options. With one exception, the moderate ones were half-day hikes. On the second day, both groups offered full-day hikes to the summit of Mount Le Conte, 16 and 12-mile versions. 9 hikers completed one or more of the 37 miles of challenging hikes, and 22 members completed one or more of the 46 miles of moderate hikes. Challenging hikes were led by Jim Goulding and Mike Schultz. Moderate hikes were led by Konnie and John Schlechte. This hike has traditionally been scheduled on Thursday through Saturday. Due to increased weekend crowds in Gatlinburg, the 2022 3-day event will be scheduled mid-week, April 19 through April 21.

CLUB PICNIC: After cancelling all social engagements (other than hikes) during 2020 and the first half of 2021, there was pent up demand to host the annual picnic in Eagle Creek Park during July. And it was a great success, with wonderful weather and more than 100 attendees. Three hikes were offered before the picnic began. Besides fried chicken and drinks provided by the Club, and a great variety of pitch in foods provided by the attendees, Bob Kriz and his son grilled hot dogs with all the trimmings for everyone at the picnic. Many thanks to our Social Committee chairperson Pat Lawler for organizing the event and her able helpers Marti Burton and Bob Kriz.

CUMBERLAND FALLS STATE PARK, KENTUCKY: 79 members and guests attended the October 22– 23, 2021 hiking event. We started the night before our first hike with a historical presentation in the lodge by the park naturalist. The park is well known for its Moonbow which appears above Cumberland Falls for a few nights each full-moon cycle. We were fortunate to view it on two of the nights we were there. 2 half-day hikes were available each day. In addition, there was a full-day hike option to the park's historic fire tower including a tour of the tower by the park naturalist. 73 hikers completed one or more of the 29 miles in hikes offered. Hikes were led by Mary Ann Layman, Konnie Schlechte, and John Schlechte. 75 members and guests attended our closing dinner in the park lodge.

WE JOINED MEETUP: In recognition of the fact that social networks have become very popular and influential in how people spend their leisure time - especially hiking - our Club decided to participate in Meetup, a social networking site, as a way to reach out to new, especially younger, members. The goal of our Meetup site is to attract a broader audience, most of who have never heard of our Club, as guests on our hikes. So far the experiment appears to be working, even though it costs several hundred dollars a year to participate. By year's end our Meetup site which lists a subset of our

upcoming hikes, has attracted over 600 followers, many of whom have commented that they did not know that a Club like ours even existed in the Indianapolis area. More than 50 Meetup members have joined our hikes as guests and upwards of a dozen have become Club members.

ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS: Now in its 16th year, this popular program recognizes hiking, trail maintenance and service accomplishments for the Club year. Awards are given in 11 categories. Winners were announced at the annual Winter Banquet and all receive a gift from the Club (usually a piece of apparel, sporting the Club logo - this year it was a hat). In 2021 we had 41 different winners of the awards (some members won more than one award), including 25 members who walked at least 1,000 miles, 1 member who completed longest hike (26 miles on the rugged Knobstone Trail); 13 who led at least 50 hikes, 5 who led at least 15 different hikes and 4 who achieved over 10,000 lifetime miles with the Club. There were also 5 winners of the Trail Maintenance award, mostly by volunteering their time in Eagle Creek Park; and three winners for the Club Service, Membership and Indyhike.org awards. WINTER BANQUET AND 65th ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION: After a one year hiatus due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the annual Winter Banquet returned on December 5. The banquet was attended by upwards of 150 Club members and guests and was a big success. A special appearance by Indianapolis Mayor Joseph Hogsett kicked off a year-long celebration for the 65th anniversary of our Club, which will begin on January 23, 2022. For the special anniversary year a new Club logo was unveiled and special logo merchandise (long and short sleeve tee shirts and hats) were offered for sale. The merchandise was very popular at the banquet and almost sold out. Following a great dinner, 41 Achievement Award winners were announced along with two new 25 year members. Mervyn Cohen then kicked off the 65th Anniversary Year with a brief presentation which concluded with a packet, which included a 65th Anniversary Book (see next section) along with other goodies, being distributed free to all Club members present at the banquet. Thank you to Social Committee Chairperson, Pat Lawler, and President Lori Showley for organizing this event and we also appreciate the many guests who donated 898 pounds of foodstuffs for disadvantaged Indianapolis families.

65th ANNIVERSARY BOOK: Early in 2021 long term member Bob Kriz approached the Board with a proposal to develop a history book to celebrate the 65th anniversary of the Club in 2022. Bob offered to fund the entire project, but he needed help to compile the book. Finding it difficult to turn down such a generous offer, the Board formed a 65th Anniversary Committee to develop the book. The committee was headed by Mervyn Cohen, Club Historian, and included the following members Harold Crooks, Ann Highway, Bob Kriz, Phil Smith, Ed Wright. After lots of hard work and many drafts a beautiful 36 page full color 65th Anniversary Book was finalized and 500 copies were printed enough for every Club member to receive a copy. True to his word, Bob Kriz paid for everything. More than 100 books were distributed to Club members in attendance at the 2021 Winter Banquet in early December along with other 65th Anniversary memorabilia provided by Bob Kriz. A follow-on effort has been undertaken by Publications Chairperson, Kae Ramey along with many helpers to locate and distribute history books to current and former Club members who were not in attendance at the Banquet. A copy of the book has been posted to the Club website.

LET'S NOT FORGET: One of the main reasons that our Club continues to be strong after 65 years is because of the traditions and friendships established by our long time members. To refresh your memory, check out the new 65th Anniversary history book which you should have received or view it on the website. Seventy three of our members have been active for 25 or more years - 20 for over 40 years. We have several 90 year olds, including Joanne Applegate, Bob Corya and Ed Lavagnino who still regularly hike and more than 20 active members in their 80s who continue to rack up miles.

Please take a moment to remember long term Club members who passed away in 2021, including: Al Crandell, Bill Flora (former Club President), Sharon Klusman, Thomas Hill (former Club President), Barb Shoufler, John Jones and Tom Hollett.

ON TO 2022: On January 23 the 65th anniversary of the Club, we will be recreating the very first hike by our Club back in 1957 - Holliday Park. We are hoping for a great turnout and memorable event. Throughout 2022 we plan to recreate additional anniversary hikes done during the Club's first year 1957. Once again in 2022 our hope is to schedule more than 2,000 hikes, giving our members almost 6 different choices every day. Monthly book Club hikes will continue once it is safe to meet outdoors. In April we will look forward to weekly wildflower hikes and spring and fall trips to Morgan Monroe State Forest as well as return visits to Gnaw bone Camp and Mary Gray Bird Sanctuary. Extended stay trips are planned to McCormick's Creek SP in March, 25th annual visit to the Smoky Mountains in April and the highlands of Scotland, which has been put off for two years due to the pandemic. Florida hikes are on the schedule for our winter snowbirds. As always, we will also host an annual picnic in July, General Assembly in September, Oktoberfest at Gnaw Bone Camp in October and Winter Banquet in early December. Make it a point to hike more during 2022 and ask your family, friends and neighbors to join you. You and your doctor will be glad you did. Hiking is good for your health and psyche, or as one long term member put it “Hiking is better than therapy”.
